### **150**

"The First Baptist Church of Baker City was organized December 7, 1874. Rev. L.J. Boothe was chairman of the meeting and Professor S.P. Barret clerk. The members present were Hardin Estes, Perline Estes, Arthur Smith, Mary Kilbourn, Samuel Gaines, Mary Gaines, Professor Barrett, Mary Barrett, and Deiazon Smith. Rev. E.P. Waltz, the first pastor of the church came from Monroe County, Missouri, arriving at Baker City January 2, 1875. S.P. Barrett, learning that a young minister was in town, contacted him and requested him to lead a prayer meeting for his church which had just recently been organized. The 20th day of March Rev. Waltz was chosen pastor and served in that capacity for 10 years."

Those words are taken out of the booklet that tells the history of what is now known as Calvary Baptist Church of Baker City, Oregon. If you do the math that means that at the end of this year, the Lord has graciously kept this congregation together for 150 years! Reading through our history, it is amazing to see how God has been faithful to this congregation. There have been many good times and some not so good times but through it all our Father has kept the doors open, the bills paid, and by far the most important thing, ministry to the community and the Word of God preached. There have been many pastors (including one J.M. Haskell in 1889, maybe a relative of Bob's?) and many, many more lay people who have given their time, energy, and love to serve the Lord at Calvary.

So why am I telling you all this? Because I think we need to celebrate! 150 years is a milestone that we shouldn't just pass by. At this point I don't have any real plans of what we should do. One thing I do know is that I would like it to be very public. Let's tell Baker City that God is on the throne, we have been around for a long time, and we are still here to love and serve Him and our neighbors.

Got any ideas? I would love to hear about them. In fact, here is the plan. On January 21st we will be having our first quarter business meeting (woo-hoo). But instead of just a meeting we will have a quick lunch, (I'm thinking pizza, I'm always thinking pizza) then our meeting and a planning meeting for our 150 year celebration. Please be thinking and especially praying about how we can use this to share the kingdom of God with our community.

And speaking of community, this April will be the 10th anniversary of our Community Dinner and we should be throwing a party about that as well.
